This concert will feature grades K-12.

Elementary Students (K-6)- We ask that your student(s) be in their regular classroom at 6:45pm so that we may get lined up and ready to sing. We also ask that if you do arrive early, to please keep your child(ren) with you until 6:45pm. The dress code for elementary students is a nice formal attire. Please do not have your students dressed in jeans, t-shirts, and/or sneakers. If you have any questions or concerns, please feel free to email.

Junior High and High School Students (7-12)- We ask students in band to be in the band room by 6:25pm to warm up. Students in junior high and high school ensembles are asked to dress nicely. (Boys: black or holiday colored dress shirt, black pants, black shoes, and black or holiday colored socks; Girls: black dresses, skirts that reach the knees, or pants and a black or holiday colored top that is appropriate for school.) Students may also wear a Christmas accessory as long as it isn't over-the-top. Tardiness or dress violations will result in a loss of points.

All students in grades K-12 are required to participate in the Christmas concert as the concert makes up a large portion of their grade.
